Dear Mr. Rodehaver,

SCG, a leading business conglomerate in the ASEAN, conducts business in line with sustainable development principles and good corporate governance for more than 107 years. SCG is assessed and listed No. 1 in the world in the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices (DJSI) as Industry Leader – Construction Materials. Also, SCG ranked in the Gold Class and co-top rank in Industry Group Leader – Materials. SCG is the first organization in ASEAN to be assessed as a member of DJSI since 2004 and continue for the 17th consecutive year. (For more information, please visit www.scg.com)

Recently, we have been questioned by many stakeholders and investors regarding the location of one of our plants in Myanmar; since, on the internet, the report, which is issued by Independent International Fact-Finding Mission on Myanmar (page 103 No.35), stated that our subsidiary, SCG Myanmar Concrete and Aggregate Company Limited (“SCG MCA”), operates in Pyinmabin Industrial Zone. The statement is factually incorrect.

Due to the nature of SCG MCA's business, SCG MCA temporarily sets up ready-mixed concrete plants in many areas to operate and supply the ready mixed concrete based on customers' requirements. Once the construction projects completed, SCG MCA removes its ready-mixed concrete plants. SCG MCA used to operate a ready-mixed concrete plant in Pyinmabin Township area, yet it never was in Pyinmabin Industrial Zone.

In addition, the land on which the plant sat actually belonged to Myanmar's Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Irrigation not Myanmar Economic Holdings Limited (“MEHL”). Lastly, although, the UN report 2019 mentioned about the plant, the operation of the plant was during 2014-2016. As of now, this plant no longer exists as the construction project it served had already completed.

Therefore, SCG would like to seek your kind cooperation to correct this fact in order to avoid any misunderstanding.
