

In our capacity as co-facilitators of the process of the consideration of the state of the UN human rights treaty body system, we are pleased to share with you further details on the modalities of the <u>virtual informal consultation with Member States in New York, scheduled on Monday, 27 July 2020, from 10:00 a.m. to 01:00 p.m.</u>

The meeting will be structured into discussions on the following issues:

- 1. Use of new information and communications technologies;
- 2. Nomination and selection process of Treaty Bodies Members;
- 3. Technical cooperation and capacity building;
- 4. Budgetary issues;
- 5. Interaction with different actors (including civil society, NHRIs and regional actors);
- 6. Individual communications

For each of the above-mentioned items, the co-facilitators will make a brief presentation based on the written contributions received, after which the floor will be opened for delegations. Delegations wishing to speak should request the floor using a link to the form for inscriptions that will be provided in the chat box, while indicating under which item they would like to intervene. Statements should be in English and not exceed 2 minutes for individual delegations and 3 minutes for groups.

Information on registration for the meeting has already been circulated by the Secretariat. The meeting will be accessible on the webcast.
