Knowledge Fair

Pursuant to resolution 37/24, the Human Rights Council will held a one-day intersessional meeting for dialogue and cooperation on human rights and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development on 16 January 2019, from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm. The meeting will focus on the theme of the 2019 session of the High Level Political Forum (HLPF)

On this occasion, the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) will a 'Knowledge Fair' during the day of the intersessional meeting. The fair provide a space for National Human Rights Institutions (NHRIs), UN agencies, NGOs, and academia and other stakeholders to showcase their experiences, tools, publications and other relevant materials concerning the human rights-based implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs.

Technical specifications

Where and when:

The Knowledge Fair will be held in the foyer of Room XX, Palais de Nations, Geneva, during the lunch break of the intersessional meeting on 16 January (from 1.00 pm to 3.00 pm). Stands will be also available to the public during before and after the meeting.

Stands:

Up to 10 stands will be made available to interested organisations, on a first-come, first-served basis. Each stand will be composed by: 1 table 160x80; 2 chairs; 1 grey panel (portrait set up mode sizing 120 wide X 180 high); 1m of Velcro tape (to cut in small pieces, in order to fix the posters on the panel). All these elements are provided free of charge.

Electronic devices

Sockets/plugs will be available for every stand. Participants will need to bring their own electronic device, such as laptops.

A limited number of TV screens will be available free of charge. LDC electronic totems can be also rented from the UNOG Production and Support service.

Lunch:

A light lunch will be served during the Fair, thanks to the generous support of the Permanent Missions of Chile and Azerbaijan.
