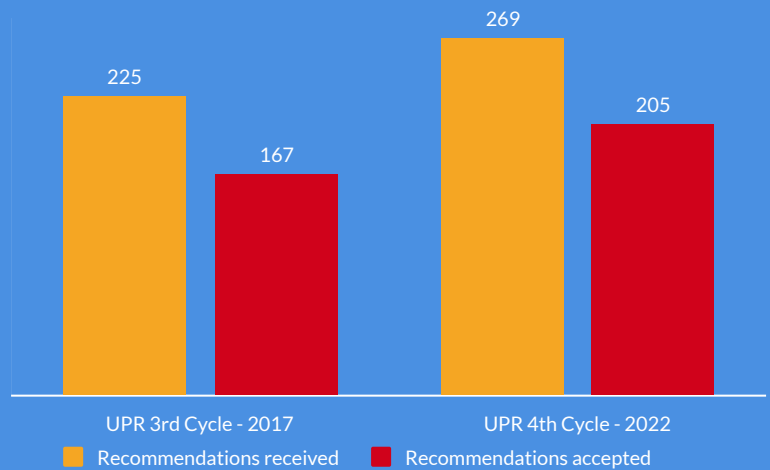
The Universal Periodic Review

Indonesia was reviewed by UPR WG 41, in November of 2022. It received 269 recommendations and it supported 205 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 52, in March 2023 (an increase of 22.75% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, International humanitarian law, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, children's rights and rights of other specific groups and persons.
