



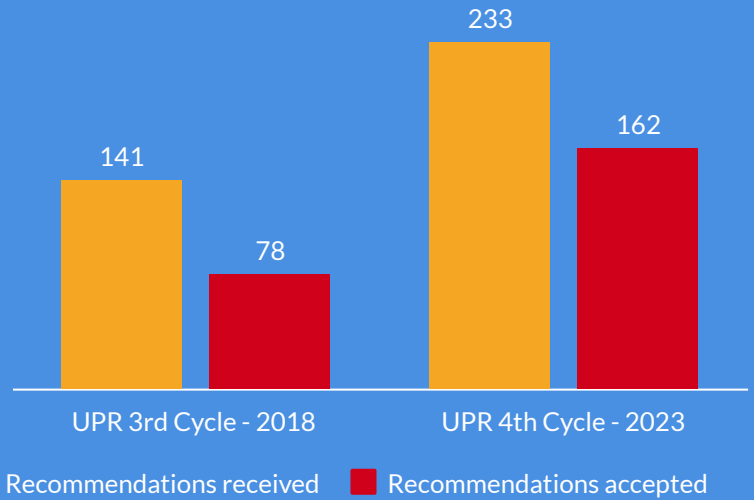
Bahamas

The Universal Periodic Review

Bahamas was reviewed by UPR WG 43, in May of 2023. It received 233 recommendations and it supported 162 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 54, in September 2023 (an increase of 65% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, children's rights and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

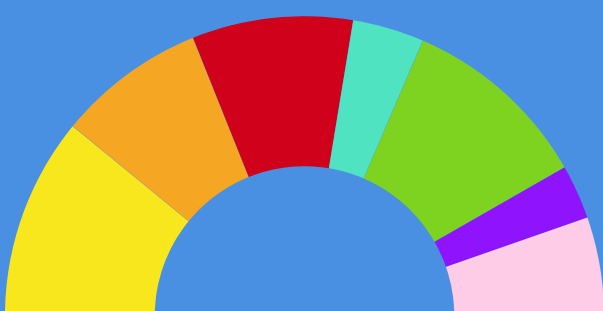
