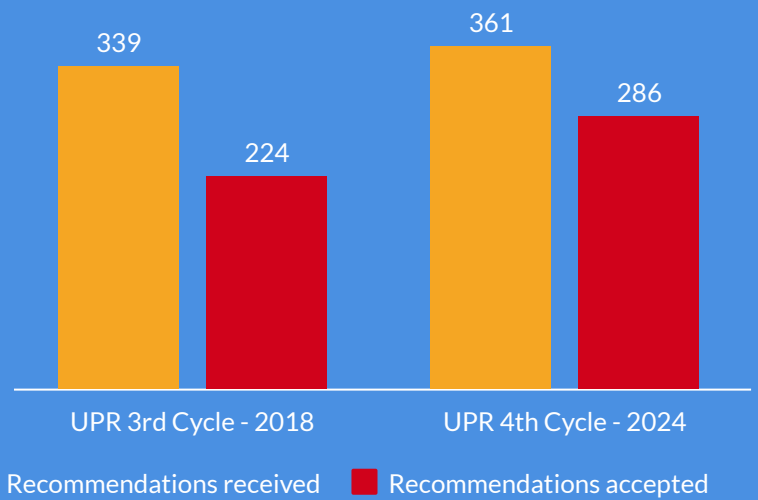

## The Universal Periodic Review

Cuba was reviewed by UPR WG 44, in November of 2023. It received 361 recommendations and it supported 286 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 55, in March 2024 (an increase of 27% with respect to the 3rd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, children's rights and rights of other specific groups and persons.

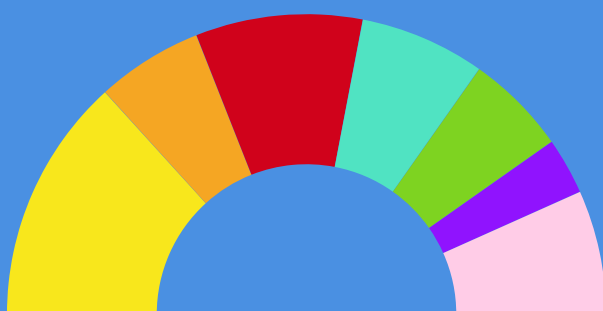
