## **Participation Guidelines**

### **Overview**

The two-day regional seminar comprises **opening remarks** followed by six moderated sessions. Each panel is made up of three to four experts who will make an initial presentation (5-7 mins each) followed by a discussion with the moderator. The final panel on day two will not have an interactive dialogue.

The **keynote panel** will last 60 minutes followed by a 90 minute general discussion for interventions and questions and answers from the floor.

Thereafter, each panel will last approximately 90 minutes including an interactive dialogue with interventions and questions from the floor.
