You know that mankind has known, during its extended history, many types of discrimination among people, such as discrimination on the basis of gender, class, religion, color, wealth, and race.

That was the time period when slavery was acceptable and legitimate.. However, with the passage of time and the emergence of social mechanisms, it has almost disappeared. In Jordan, while some deposits are still practiced in hidden ways, There are also deposits associated with Arab culture in the form of proverbs that are said among people as a matter of contempt. Yes, the voice of colored people has become heard in my country, who assumed positions in parliament, as ambassador, as senior officers in the army and security forces, as minister, as well as presidents of universities, sports, and influential personalities, marriage black and white vice versa became ordinary.

The outward inequality of black people has been nearly ended, not even their tolerance for any racial discriminatory practice, whether in the judiciary or in violent confrontation.
