


Zambia

The Universal Periodic Review

Zambia was reviewed by UPR WG 28, in November of 2017. It received 203 recommendations and it supported 183 recommendations at the adoption of its UPR outcome at Human Rights Council 37, in March 2018 (an increase of 93% with respect to the 2nd cycle).

Supported recommendations related to: Legal and general framework of implementation, universal and cross-cutting issues, civil and political rights, economic, social, and cultural rights, women's rights, and rights of other vulnerable groups and persons.

Trends in supported recommendations




Top 5 Sustainable Development Goals*
