



**Pledge submitted by Georgia to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat
December 2023**

Original language of submission: English

Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor)

Pledging entity: The Administration of the Government of Georgia

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: The government of Georgia will adopt a National Human Rights Action Plan, which involves all three branches of the government; covers a broad range of human rights; focuses on the localization of fundamental freedoms; creates obligations for public and private entities; and ensures effective implementation of the anti-discrimination legislation. For the first time, the civil society together with the state agencies will be actively involved not only in elaboration of the Action Plan but also in its implementation. In addition, for the first time, the National Action Plan on Human Rights will have its own budget.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2024
