



**Pledge submitted by Thailand to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat
December 2023**

Original language of submission: English
Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor)
Pledging entity: Royal Thai Government

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Advance human rights commitments and actions by: (a) ratify ICPPED, by early 2024, and strengthen its implementation including through capacity-building exercises and continued engagement with other countries and partners including relevant mechanisms of the United Nations; (b) redouble efforts in promoting the efficiency of the justice process including through the implementation of the recently passed Act on Time Limitation in the Justice Process of 2022; and (c) further advance gender equality, including through passing and upgrading relevant legislations.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Jun 30, 2024

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: Upgrade relevant national infrastructure in dealing with new global challenges that have human rights implications, including climate change and environment, by setting up dedicated agencies and investing in capacity building as well as passing relevant legislation.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2024

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: Provide human rights education and training for government officials and all sectors of the society, with the support, cooperation and partnership with related government agencies, academia, the National Human Rights Commission and relevant organizations under the United Nations.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2025

PLEDGE NUMBER 4: Institutionalise regular and meaningful engagement with youth through various platforms and mechanisms of government agencies and enhanced partnership among all stakeholders to empower youth and promote youth's proactive role as well as positive contribution to the communities and society.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2025

PLEDGE NUMBER 5: Enhance the quality and access to health services for all people, with a particular focus on using technology and innovations to upgrade existing Universal Health Coverage schemes at the national and local levels, improving mechanisms for health promotion and disease prevention as well as palliative care, and reaching the target of health impoverishment rate below 0.25% of Thai population by 2027.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2027
