



Pledge submitted by Zimbabwe to the Human Rights 75 Secretariat
December 2023

Original language of submission: English

Type of pledge: Single (by one state/actor)

Pledging entity: Ministry of Justice, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs

PLEDGE NUMBER 1: Avail legislative, policy and administrative measures to facilitate the ratification of the Convention for the Protection of all Persons from Enforced Disappearances; and the International Convention on the Protection of Rights of all Migrant Workers and Members of their Families, by 2027.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2027

PLEDGE NUMBER 2: Implement capacity building of the 5 pillars of Community Based Rehabilitation with particular attention to, health, education, livelihoods, social development, empowerment and the meaningful engagement of persons with disabilities in key decision-making platforms, by 2030.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2030

PLEDGE NUMBER 3: Decentralise and expand provision of legal aid services for indigent persons in particular women, children and persons with disabilities through the establishment of at least one legal aid office in each of the 72 administrative districts of the country at a rate of three (3) new district offices each year, and ensuring that the requisite legislation for the provision of legal aid service is revised and aligned to the provisions of the constitution and international human rights standards.

Expected deadline within which pledge will be realised: Dec 31, 2035
